## 2012 Mass Survey

Universe
Constituted by individuals from 18 to 70 years old, and living in mainland Portugal.

## Sample

Multi-stage probability sample:
$1^{\text {st }}$ ) stratified by region and habitat;
$2^{\text {nd }}$ ) random route to selection of households;
$3^{\text {rd }}$ ) Selection of individuals in households taking into account birthday.
Consisting of 1,209 interviews, with the following distribution, proportional by NUT region:
